Brandon’s Blurp:

I was listening to a pastor recently who talked about what it meant to pray for revival and awakening. He used an illustration that resonated with me as a father of two young boys. He said, “When we pray for revival, we’re acknowledging that something is amiss. We have fallen or are in need of great help like a child who has tripped on a gravel driveway and bloodied their knee.”

He then went on to talk about what happens when God answers our prayers by saying, “When God revives and heals His Church, he removes everything that would prevent her from truly healing. That means He will remove the gravel out of the Church’s knee. But the Church, much like a little child who fell, will say ‘No! No! I do it!’ while doctoring *around* the wound instead of actually cleaning the wound.

When God heals us, he gets the gravel out of our knee instead of letting us play doctor. This is especially hard because that process can (and often does) hurt.

So, knowing this we grit our teeth and pray with the Psalmist, “Create in me a clean heart and renew a right spirit within me.”
