Following Jesus requires us to take off any behaviors that would alter our appearance and reduces us to simply obeying Him. No frills. Nowhere to hide. It's vulnerable. It's beautiful. It takes discipline. You'll need clarity and self-control. But the end result is worth it.

I encourage you to walk in obedience of Jesus and experience the freedom that He gives. When you do, it'll be the sweetest sound anyone could hear.
